**X-Out 41 Plus** is a post-emergent, non-selective, systemic herbicide that mixes readily with water to be applied as a foliar spray for the control or destruction of most herbaceous plants. **X-Out 41 Plus** moves through the target plant from foliage contact point and into the root system. Visible control effects on most annual weeds occur within 2 to 4 days, and up to 7 days or more on perennial weeds. These include gradual wilting and yellowing of the target plant which advance to the complete browning of above-ground growth and deterioration of the underground plant parts and root system.

Rainfall or irrigation occurring within 6 hours after application may reduce effectiveness. Heavy rainfall or irrigation within 2 hours after application may wash the chemical off the foliage and a repeat treatment may be required.

- Provides control of a wide variety of annual and perennial weeds, woody brush and trees
- Can be applied with most industrial and field-type sprayers
